

Miller Mountain

Introducing Wyoming County's First STATE FORESTLAND

Just south of Tunkhannock lies Miller Mountain, a sprawling standalone peak that rises more than 2,000 feet above town. The mountain's history is almost as impressive as its sheer size. It has been farmed, logged, and even considered for a ski resort, a plan that ultimately failed in the 1980s.

Now, the mountain is beginning a new chapter as public land. In fall 2023, the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) announced that Miller Mountain would become part of the Pinchot State Forest. The state partnered with The Conservation Fund and Williams to purchase the 2,500-acre property.

District Forester Nicholas Lylo described Miller Mountain as the gateway to the Endless Mountains. "As you come up Route 29 and enter into the river valley of Tunkhannock and Eaton Township, it's the first real landmark that greets you," he explained.

A year earlier, Wyoming County welcomed its first state park at Vosburg Neck. The new state forestland at Miller Mountain marks another key milestone for outdoor recreation in the Endless Mountains.

"As I was walking down the main street of Tunkhannock, I could see that Miller Mountain forms the backdrop of the town," recalled Kyle Shenk, Northeast Regional Director of The Conservation Fund. "In my mind, that's an important piece of the character of the town and the sense of place that you get while you're there."


The property is currently open for passive recreation such as walking, hiking, biking, birdwatching, hunting, and fishing. All state forest rules and regulations apply (visit dcnr.pa.gov/ StateForests/RulesAndRegulations for details). Visitors should make sure to respect private property, which borders the mountain on all sides.

The Bureau of Forestry is still in the early stages of establishing boundary lines and assessing the mountain's resources. As of winter 2024, trail maps, designated parking lots, and other amenities are not yet available. However, there are existing, unblazed logging paths that lead to breathtaking vistas.

"It's really a 'choose your own adventure' kind of place right now, which I think is exciting for some people and might be a little bit out of the comfort zone for others," said Shenk. "But there are places right on the edge that have beautiful views. You don't have to go deep into the woods to enjoy the property."

As access expands over the next few years, Miller Mountain has the potential to become a premier outdoor destination. For updates on the property, please visit DCNR's website at dcnr.pa.gov.



NICHOLSON Tourism Center *A New Beginning for a Historic Train Station*

Decades before the Tunkhannock Creek Viaduct rose to fame, another local landmark was at the heart of Nicholson. The Historic Delaware, Lackawanna & Western (DL&W) Railroad Station was once a hub for freight and passengers. It even served as the town's post office for many years.


Now, the building has a new life as the Nicholson Tourism Center. Renovated and maintained by the Nicholson Heritage Association, the building houses artifacts and exhibits that tell the story of a small town that shaped Northeastern Pennsylvania's railroading history.

History of the Station

The train station was originally built in 1849 by the Liggett's Gap Railroad, a predecessor to the DL&W. It was the first station on the line from Scranton to Great Bend. The station became a bustling place that connected the little town of Nicholson to the wider world. In the railroad's heyday, passengers could catch direct trains to Hoboken, Binghamton, Buffalo, and Oswego. In the freight area, local farmers shipped goods like apples, milk, and cheese to market, while trains brought crucial supplies into town. It was so esteemed that the first telephone line in Northeastern Pennsylvania ran between the Nicholson station and the DL&W station in Scranton.

Back then, the original rail line followed what is now Route 11. The railroad was notorious for its steep grades, sharp curves, and dangerous road crossings. "Pusher" locomotives were always ready and waiting in Nicholson to move heavy, loaded trains out of the valley.

To make the route safer and more efficient, the DL&W built an improved rail line called the Clarks Summit-Hallstead Cutoff. Part of the plan was to construct two massive concrete bridges: the Tunkhannock Creek Viaduct in Nicholson and the Martins Creek Viaduct in Kingsley. In 1915, the famous "Nicholson Bridge" opened, and the passenger service moved to a new station at the top of the hill. Meanwhile, the original station continued to handle freight.





Saving a Piece of the Past

Over time, the railroad industry declined in Northeastern Pennsylvania. The station ultimately closed in 1971, and a local business bought it for storage space. However, the Nicholson Heritage Association realized that the station was a priceless piece of the town's history. In 2012, they purchased the property with a Pepsi Refresh grant and donations from countless individuals and local businesses.

"If the Heritage Association hadn't had the opportunity to purchase it, I think it would have eventually just deteriorated to nothing," said Josh Stull, vice chair of the Nicholson Heritage Association. "It's more than 170 years old. How many train stations—and even buildings themselves—still exist that are that old?"

Renovating a historic building was no easy task. It took eleven years to bring the station back to its former glory. In July 2023, the Nicholson Tourism Center at the Historic DL&W Station officially opened to the public.

Instead of cargo loads, the freight room now contains artifacts from Nicholson's history. Visitors can browse through exhibits about the railroad and the viaduct, admire the collection of Lenape arrowheads that were found near Tunkhannock Creek, or check out the original working scale. In the old office area, guests can get a glimpse of the day-to-day life of a station agent. An original desk is still there, donated by the family of former station agent Elmer Sweppenheiser.

The passenger area truly captures the elegance of the era. Visitors can step up to the original ticket window or take a seat on the massive replica bench where people would wait for their trains. From the landing, you're treated to a view of the viaduct as it arches over the town. If you're lucky, you might even see a train chugging along.

Visit the Nicholson Tourism Center

For railroad enthusiasts, the station is a must-see stop, especially since it's so close to other attractions in Northeastern Pennsylvania. Steamtown National Historic Site, the Electric City Trolley Museum, the Anthracite Heritage Museum, the Lackawanna Coal Mine Tour, historic Honesdale, and the D&H Gravity Railroad Museum are less than an hour away from Nicholson.

"Everything is connected because of the history of the railroad," explained Stull. "Go east of here on the Viaduct Valley Scenic Byway, and you can see the Starrucca Viaduct. You can travel nine miles north and see the Martins Creek Viaduct."





The Butterfly Project Mural

Location: Rear of Greenwood's Furniture, 61 East Tioga St., Tunkhannock Artists & Contributors: Bob & Lavona Daniels, Gail Long, Peg Morris, Merriel Oliver, Carlos Penedos, Marta Kovacs-Ruiz, Michelle Thomas, & the Monsey Family

Tunkhannock resident Merriel Oliver dreamed about turning Tunkhannock into a "butterfly town," not only to raise awareness about the importance of pollinators but also to encourage ecotourism, art, and events in the community. In a grassroots effort, she gathered a group of community members who called themselves "The Butterfly People." Each person brought their talents and vision to the mural, which depicts swallowtail butterflies in a field of colorful flowers.





Dushore's 150th Anniversary

Artist: Karen Black

This mural was completed in 2009 to celebrate the 150th anniversary of Dushore's incorporation. Sullivan County artist Karen Black painted it on nine separate boards, each three feet by ten feet. Every panel shares pieces of Dushore's history with many hidden stories along the way.

"I've always loved history, so I spent many hours at the local museum looking at photos and talking to people who remembered certain decades," said Black. "I love challenges that murals bring. Each one has its own unique hurdles to conquer and a unique message for the viewers."

Factoryville: Hometown of Christy Mathewson

Location: College Ave. & Maple St., Factoryville Artist: Unknown

Six panels honor legendary pitcher Christy Mathewson, who was born in Factoryville in 1880 and attended Keystone Academy (now Keystone College). He went on to play professional baseball for the New York Giants and the Cincinnati Reds and became one of the first inductees to the Baseball Hall of Fame. The mural includes fascinating stats from Mathewson's baseball career.





Forest City Trail Town Mural

Location: 503 Main St., Forest City *Artist:* Jeff George

This 1,800-square-foot mural welcomes visitors to Forest City, a charming town along the D&H Rail-Trail. It portrays many of the animals that you may see around the Greater Forest City area, while hikers and cyclists give a nod to the town's boundless outdoor recreation opportunities.

Murals of the Endless Mountains

With our breathtaking scenery and rich heritage, it's no wonder the Endless Mountains have inspired larger-than-life artwork. Check out these spectacular murals as you explore our communities.



In the Moment (Of Then and Now)

Location: Lobby of the Mattern Building, 7406 Route 487, Mildred *Artist:* Cat Badger

Cat Badger has painted murals throughout the country, but her recent project brought her home to Sullivan County.

"Whether you were born here, are a new resident, or just visiting, I think this mural has a lot to offer," said Badger. "My hope is that it continues to provide recognition to prior generations, inform younger people, generate curiosity, and inspire other artists to do the same."

The mural acts like a timeline, beginning with early industries such as coal mining, lumbering, and railroading. The middle portion shows scenes from the Keystone State Shoe Company, the original tenant of the Mattern Building. The final section displays landmarks like Ganoga Falls at Ricketts Glen State Park, the Forksville Covered Bridge, and the sign at Worlds End State Park.

Sullivan County Wildlife Display

Location: Lobby of the Sullivan County Courthouse, 245 Muncy St., Laporte

Artist: Karen Black, assisted by student Hayden Baumunk

When the Mokoma Inn was demolished, the Sullivan County Courthouse preserved the hotel's collection of mounted animals. Over time, however, the display needed some TLC. Local artist Karen Black created a new mural of the Loyalsock Creek to replace the original backdrop from 1940. Taxidermist Nancy Craft restored the animals, some of which are over 100 years old. Forty-two different species are included in the collection, and even more flora and fauna are painted into the mural. If you're up for a challenge, see how many painted animals you can find!





Sunflower

Location: East Tioga & Bridge St., Tunkhannock, PA *Artist:* Leigh Pawling

Located at Tunkhannock's main intersection, a cheerful sunflower and colorful butterflies welcome visitors into town. Look closely, and you'll notice the mural mirrors the sunflower patten on the building's original cornice.

Artist Leigh Pawling worked with building owner Carlos Penedos to create this stunning focal point.

"He had a huge scaffolding, which hid the entire building so I would climb up and down to first draw the outline of the flower and then paint it using a grid method," recalled Pawling. "It was so exciting because there was a true unveiling of the mural when the cover and scaffolding came down."

The Dietrich Theater's mural project captures the area's heritage and scenery. On the back of the theater, two massive murals depict the famous Tunkhannock Creek Viaduct. Tunkhannock artist Bob Lizza used a trompe l'oeil (or "trick of the eye") effect to make the mural look three-dimensional, as if you could step right into the scene. The side of the theater features a panoramic view of the Vosburg Neck, a majestic oxbow bend in the Susquehanna River. The mural was completed in 2021, about a year before Vosburg Neck was named one of Pennsylvania's newest state parks.

G ather the family and fill your buckets at this pick-your-own blueberry patch in Tunkhannock. The berries are typically ripe by July 1 and continue throughout the month. After a day in the field, stop by the **Berry Hut**, where you'll find small-batch preserves and refreshments like delicious apple cider slushies. You can also stroll down the lane to see the flower meadow, which is a natural habitat for butterflies.





Brown Hill Farms near Tunkhannock offers stunning views that you just have to see to believe. The fun begins in late April or early May when the fields are filled with over 400,000 tulips and 25,000 daffodils. In August, visitors can stroll through the sunflower trail, complete with 30 acres of blooms and a special you-cut field with over 30 varieties of flowers to choose from. New for 2024, they will also offer you-pick vegetables like tomatoes, peppers, cucumbers, and squashes during sunflower season. Finally, September and October bring classic fall fun like pumpkin picking, a corn maze, and wagon rides. Plan to spend the day because **Brown Hill** offers lots of family activities like play areas for the kids, Instagrammable photo ops, and adorable farm animals (seriously, who can resist those fluffy Highlander cows?).

enningstead Organic Farm in Mehoopany has a long history of farming. In fact, this organic dairy farm has been in the same family since 1847. In the summer, visit the Berry Barn to pick your own raspberries and blackberries. Raspberries are usually ready in mid-July with blackberries following about two weeks after. Prime picking continues through September. While you're there, stock up the farm's own artisanal cheese, honey, and maple syrup.






